Job Description: Rhythmic Gymnastics Coach

Effective: January 1, 2018 or earlier

The Wascana Rhythmic Gymnastics Club (WRGC) is looking to hire an experienced Rhythmic Gymnastics Coach who will focus on the development of the Provincial stream and Interclub athletes, as well as assist with National Level stream athletes. Both roles will be in collaboration with our Head Coach.

WRGC is the largest RG club in Saskatchewan and based in Regina with a large component of the club's membership in rural communities surrounding the city of Regina. We are a non-profit club which has been in operation for 21 years.

Our requirements include:

- NCCP Level 2 certification or higher, or the ability to get Canadian equivalency for certification from outside the country.
- Minimum 2 years experience in the development of programming and the coaching of provincial and interclub competitive athletes (and preferably national level, but not required).
- Experience with Russian style ballet (preferred, but not required).
- University degree in Physical Education, Kinesiology, or Sport Science or equivalent (industry standard) is required.
- Specific skills required include technical coaching of gymnasts for provincial and national competitions, physical preparation, music selection, choreography and script preparation.
- Choreograph athletes' routines including music selection
- Excellent coaching, interpersonal and communication skills
- Judging experience preferred, but not required
- Confident and positive with gymnasts of all ability levels

- Being dedicated to making rhythmic gymnastics a positive and enjoyable experience
- Ability to follow club policies and health and safety procedures
- Ensure the WRGC and Gymnastics Saskatchewan Athlete's code of conduct is maintained.
- Administrative skills such as email, Word and general administrative use of computers
- Mentor part-time, junior and coaches in training to develop and continually improve the standard of the coaching staff.
- Self-starter, willing to lead without direction.
- The ability to communicate in English both orally and written is a requirement. Fluency in other languages would be considered an asset but not a requirement.
- The Coach will be required to work with the club governance structure of a Board of Directors and will report to the Board of Directors.
- Perform related duties as assigned.
- Criminal record check

Terms of employment: Permanent position, with approximately 30 hours per week in the evenings and weekends in the gym. There is a three month probationary period.

The majority of the work will be located in Regina, Saskatchewan, with the potential to travel to gymnastic competitions, camps and galas within the province and nationally.
