

Continuing Professional Education (CPE) Hours

- To maintain active judging status, judges must complete CPE yearly.
- The number of hours required is dictated by the highest level of certification held. Refer to chart below.
- To diversify judge experience there are a maximum number of CPE hours allowed in each category.
i.e. a JO 8&9 judge can attend both days of the Optional Clinic (16 hours total) however they may only count a MAXIMUM of 8 of these hours towards total CPE hours.
- Approval of activities outside those listed below, is under the discretion of the WJC.
- **CPE hours must be completed and submitted to P/T chair prior to Provincial Championships.**

Attending a Course: Judges may audit courses to earn CPE hours. Audit=attendance without writing exam(s).

Judging Sessions: Each session judged at a competition will equal 2 CPE hours.

Practice Hours: Practice hours should include a mechanism for feedback (from another coach or judge) i.e. mock meets, judge practice in the gym or on-line.

Coaching: the number of hours/week you coach=the number CPE hours you may count. i.e. if you coach 3 hours/week, you count 3 CPE hours for the year.

Classroom Education (excluding Certification Courses): workshops, mini-clinics, etc

Other Judging related activities: course conductor, committee member, presenter, etc.
