The Queen City Gymnastics Club of Regina, SK has an exciting opportunity for a qualified and experienced Women's Artistic Gymnastics / Men's Artistic Gymnastics Coach (WAG/MAG). The position will be at the Queen City Gymnastics Club 455 Maxwell Cres. Regina, SK. This is a permanent, full-time position.

Queen City Gymnastics (QCG) has been providing recreational and competitive gymnastics programming in Regina, SK for over 30 years. In its most recent season there were more than 10,000 visits to the facility by its members and community users, including 100+ competitive/pre-competitive athletes and 600+ recreational athletes.

The competitive program has athletes in the Women's and Men's Artistic Gymnastics disciplines who compete at all levels from development through to National.

The Queen City Gymnastics Club has moved into a new facility in the summer of 2017 making this a timely opportunity for a passionate high performance gymnastics coach to join the existing coaching staff as the club moves forward in growing its membership base and in becoming a center of excellence for gymnastics.

### **Salary and Terms of Employment**

The rate of pay for this position will be negotiated based on experience and qualifications.

This is a permanent, full-time, hourly position, requiring flexible hours, evenings and weekend work.

The WAG/MAG Competitive Coach will not only be responsible for training their specific group but may also be asked to take on club bookings, recreational class coverage, and other duties as needed or assigned by the Board of Directors or designate

### **Qualifications**

**The WAG Competitive Coach will have the following minimum qualifications:**

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Level 2 or higher NCCP Artistic Trained or equivalent
- Level 2 Trampoline Certification or equivalent (optional)
- Valid Criminal record Check, including Vulnerable Population Check
- Valid Driver's license
- Valid Emergency First Aid and CPR Training
- Extensive knowledge of the Canadian Artistic Gymnastics Program would be an asset

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

**The WAG/MAG Competitive Coach is responsible for (but not limited to):**

- Work with the QCG Board of Directors or designate and the WAG/MAG lead coaches to contribute to an annual WAG/MAG Club and Athlete Development Plan, including reporting and evaluation of performance measures and targets
- Find substitute coaches/back-up coaches for competitive program as required.
- Athlete reporting and tracking (in consultation with QC lead coaches and/or QCG Board of Directors or designate). Coach select groups of athletes as assigned or required.
- Participate in promotional events to recruit more WAG/MAG members
- Fill in for absent coaches in the WAG/MAG program
- Escalate all parent/athlete issues to the QCG Board of Directors or designate (when needed)
- Attend staff meetings and training sessions as required.
- Other duties may be added as required.
