We at Lakeland Gymnastics (LLGC) work together to provide quality gymnastics programming for all levels of development and achievements for our gymnasts.

Position Description:

The Competitive Head Coach is assigned the primary responsibility to coordinate, organize, develop, implement, supervise and evaluate all aspects of the competitive program requirements in a fiscally responsible manner; this includes supporting athletes and coaches. In this role, you will be working alongside of the office manager and recreational head coach and will be responsible for providing support as well as various programming and coaching duties pertaining to daily operations of the club.

Duties will include, but are not limited to:

- General office administration
 - Responding to parents questions regarding classes, and programs via phone and email, keeping all program material filed and organized.
- Taking registration for all Gymnastics programs when required
- Updating registration programs with new class times and coaches in collaboration with the office manager and recreational coach.
- The Head Coach supervises and mentors and aids in evaluation of the Recreational, Competitive and Pre-Competitive Coaches. Works with and lends support to the coaching team, by supervising and programming these programs for performance and growth.
- The Head Coach is responsible for the development, implementation and evaluation of programs for competitive athletes and assistant coaches in the gym.
- The Head Coach will oversee the organization and operations of the competitive gymnastics programs and coaches.
- Communicate with the Board of Directors via email/phone on a regular basis.
- Head coaches will be asked to attend monthly board meetings, to lend support, advice and insight with regards to coaching staff, athletes and operations of the club.

- Motivation to work in a high paced environment
- Professional customer service skills
- Superior communication skills both one on one and in-group settings

- Customer service orientated
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail
- Strong spotting skills for all levels of gymnasts

Requirements:

- Have the ability to plan and organize activities
- Willing to coach girls and boys all levels and ages
