Hello Clubs,

During this uncertain time, we would like to assure you that upcoming Membership Assistance Program (MAP) Grants will continue to be dispersed as usual. We will run the reports to determine the total members per club and membership fees paid to Gym Sask on May 15th. We will then run the calculations to provide clubs with their MAP Grant amounts. Applications and follow-up reports will follow as usual. We will send out more information about how to apply for MAP Grants in May.

The Government of Canada is offering temporary wage subsidy for employers for a three month period that will allow eligible employers to reduce the amount of payroll deductions required to be remitted to CRA. Non-profit organizations and businesses with a business number and payroll program account with CRA on March 18, 2020 are eligible.
