Gym Sask supports clubs in the delivery of high quality, systematic and integrated programs for inter-club stream athletes.	All competitive clubs have registered athletes participating in provincially recognized JO, Fast Cat, Rhythm Cat, pre-competitive and inter-club programs.	
Gym Sask leads and supports high quality, systematic and integrated talent identification and competition programs for provincial stream athletes.	All competitive clubs are participating in provincially recognized programs for WAG, MAG, TG, ACRO and RG Provincial Stream levels. Provincial Champions are declared in all competitive levels.	
Gym Sask leads and supports high quality, systematic and integrated talent identification, development and competition programs for national level and high performance athletes. 
