With COVID and the challenges that the variants bring, we have opted to add a 'VIRTUAL' option to our competition. The submitted routines will be judged along with the in-person routines within each session. Awards & athlete gifts will be shipped to clubs. Fees remain the same for all registrants. See Virtual section within our meet package for details.

Door Entry:

In an effort to reduce contact during our event, there will only be 2 spectators allowed per gymnast per session. We normally collect \$10 for each spectator which includes your program and score sheet. This will be collected in advance with your registration fees, see included worksheet within the registration worksheet. Note, the list of gymnasts for each session will be at the entry and will be checked.

Athletes will be considered registered when the Registration File, including the completed Coach's Sheet, Waivers, Payment, Door Entry & music are received. Registration will be on a first paid, first registered basis. The number of athletes per category may be limited.

Refunds:

All medical withdrawals, includes withdrawals for positive COVID tests and those **not fully vaccinated with a close contact**, will be accepted 24 hours prior to the athlete's competition day, **minus a \$25 administration fee**, emailed to the Meet Director. <u>NO</u> direct emails from the families, only the clubs please. No medical note will be required.

Virtual withdrawals will be accepted until **February 21**st at **10pm**, via emailed to the Meet Director.

If you are to compete Saturday, your club will need to email by 10am Friday, if you compete Sunday, then the club will need to email by 10am Saturday.

Unless, where you compete in the last session (evening) of the day, we would need to be notified by 5pm of the previous day.

Door entry fees will only be refunded where a medical withdrawal has been accepted. **No Refunds** will be made where the spectator fails to meet our COVID protocols outlined in this registration package.

Late Entry: Registrations received after February 1st, will be subject to a \$25 late fee per athlete.

Changes: Coaches wishing to change athlete level(s) after February 1st, will have to pay a \$25 level change fee

before level is changed. NO changes will be accepted at the meet! Any changes before that date can

be done via email to the Meet Director.

Virtual: When completing the athlete registration form, type VIRTUAL, in the column where indicated for those

competing Virtual. For those clubs competing Virtual, there will be a separate document emailed to you

outlining our Virtual Video submission procedures once registration is received.

Video Streaming: We are working to provide video streaming of this event for those who will not attend in person.

Technical: As per Saskatchewan and Canadian technical Regulations, Canadian CPP Manual, and GCG Aspire

COVID: All items below are subject to change without notice if restrictions are imposed by the government of

Saskatchewan or Gymnastics Saskatchewan:

Assumption of Risk forms are required for all gymnasts. This form must be completed and returned with

the registration package.

All Provincial Government COVID-19 health guidelines will be followed during the competition.

Spectators will be allowed with capacity controlled, only 2 spectators per athlete per session.

All Coaches, spectators, judges and volunteers must masked at all times and will show proof of full vaccination or if not fully vaccinated a negative COVID test within the last 48 hours upon admittance to the facility. Self-conducted tests will **NOT** be accepted. Tests will only be accepted if completed by a certified clinic.

Gymnasts must wear masks at all times when not performing gymnastics on the events. Masks will be required during general warmup for the gymnasts.

Equipment: As per the Gymnastics Saskatchewan Technical Regulations, Clubs are welcome to bring

their own beat board. All equipment is AAI & Spieth Anderson and fully adjustable.
