



## **Team Saskatchewan Gymnaestrada (TSG): Call for Team Managers**

TSG is now accepting applications for team managers for the 2021-2023 cycle! Successful applicants will be part of the TSG management team starting in September 2021, and ending after the 2022 Canadian Gymnaestrada. If TSG is named to Team Canada to attend the 2023 World Gymnaestrada, the same applicants may continue as management until the end of World Gymnaestrada. *Applications should be submitted with the full two-year commitment in mind.*

All managers must be in good standing with Gymnastics Saskatchewan and be a minimum of 21 years of age at the time of Canadian Gymnaestrada (June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021).

**Deadline to apply is Sept 18th, 2021!**

### **Specific Roles and Responsibilities (as per TSG Program Document)**

- Be in direct contact with the General Manager for duration of the TSG program, with a quick response time (especially when working with deadlines).
- Act as either an assigned chaperone or assistant to the General Manager at Gymnaestrada.
- Travel to Gymnaestrada on specified dates as indicated by the General Manager.
- Support and assist the General Manager, and TSG Coaches as needed.
- Be available for any projects or tasks the General Manager may assign.
- Remain informed about the program by reading all communication sent out to the team and asking questions when needed.
- Make an effort to get to know the athletes on the team during the training season and before the time of travel.
- Be an excellent ambassador of TSG and Gym Sask.

The number of team managers selected will be dependent on the number, ages, and identified genders of participants in the program. Applicants should have experience in supervising young children and/or managing adults and be familiar with the Gymnaestrada programs (preferably Canadian or World). Team managers must be registered members in good standing with Gymnastics Saskatchewan, whether through a club or directly through Gym Sask.

Team managers will receive mid and year-end evaluations by the General Manager to ensure all staff are aware of their responsibilities and how they may need to improve for the rest of the cycle. These evaluations will be followed up prior to travelling with the team. Team managers not fulfilling their expectations and responsibilities will be replaced.

TSG team managers are volunteers throughout the training season; however, all travel expenses to Gymnaestrada will be arranged and covered by Gymnastics Saskatchewan. Team Managers will be required to submit criminal records check with the vulnerable sectors check.
