### 3. Technical Regulations 2021-2022 review and discussion

#### a. New programs – Sask Inter-Club levels & Provincials levels

Verbal update on the new Inter-Club levels in Saskatchewan. Documents have been emailed out and posted on the Gym Sask website. JO program is now called the Canadian Competitive Program (CCP) as per Gym Can documents.

#### b. Age Groups

Age groups have been published and sent out to clubs. Updates will be made in January if necessary. Numbers are looking very good, same or better than pre-pandemic.

#### c. Judging Program Changes (Toni)

Toni provided a verbal update on judging. Women's Judging Committee (WJC) voted that judges can go back to their level they were pre-pandemic pending they complete a module. Saskatchewan sent 53 judges to the Ontario virtual judging course for level 1-5. Gym Can has put together a national judging course. Need to certify more Xcel judging, for Sask Games and also in general. Working on a course for this but will also reach out to Ontario to see if we can use their course.

#### d. XCEL Program

Xcel Bronze & Silver are now Inter-club. Xcel Gold, Diamond & Platinum are competitive and will be able to attend Provincials as long as they qualify for this event.

### 4. Competitive Program Review

#### a. Calendar of events review

Planning for in person events, Kristi provided verbal update on the calendar of events. Provincials will be in Yorkton May 13-15.

Discussion on vaccine mandates for club events and provincials. Policy will be discussed at the Gym Sask level for Provincials and sent to clubs when something is in place. Discussion around club events, a section in the meet registration package should include whether or not a club is implementing a vaccine or negative test policy. If possible, clubs would like to know soon what host clubs are doing so they can plan their calendar.

#### b. Sask First

Chris provided verbal update on Sask First 2020-2021. Virtual trials were held, with 14 athletes named to 2 tiers. Two training camps held one in November, one in August. Athletes attended virtual competitions throughout the year with many medal performances. Rylee Miller named to Senior HP list with Espoir status, Amy Jorgensen named to Junior National Team.

**c. Canadians**

JO 9 both age categories are now considered national level and will be attending Canadians. Date and location are still TBD. Will provide update once Gym Can announces.

**d. Westerns**

Westerns will be held in Winnipeg in April, trials are the GA invitational at the end of March,

**5. Sask Games 2022**

Gym Sask was withdrawn from the MAG, TG and RG portion of SWG for 2022. Will host a WAG only competition for birth years 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2012. Xcel Gold will be the level with all four events, instead of three like previous. All information can be found on the Gym Sask website.
